Dholera SIR to host investor conclave before Vibrant Gujarat



To pitch the Dholera Special Investment Region as an investment destination during the next year's Vibrant Gujarat Global Summit (VGGS), authorities have planned an investor conclave prior to the event.

"The CM (Gujarat chief minister Vijay Rupani) had said that Dholera will be the main investment destination to be projected at the Vibrant Summit of 2019. So we have planned to hold a pre-Vibrant summit in Dholera," said the managing director of Dholera Industrial City Development Ltd, Jai Prakash Shivhare, today.

"Several theme-based seminars will be organised three or four months prior to the main biennial event of 2019," he said.

Shivhare was here to attend 'Defence Conclave 2018', organised by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII). Several international players including Lockheed Martin and Airbus have shown interest in starting operations in the upcoming industrial city, he said.

The Dholera SIR is around 100 km from Ahmedabad.

Work for the proposed greenfield international airport at Dholera will start this year, Shivhare said.

"The total cost of the international airport project would be Rs 2,125 crore. It will have two runways. Since we have received all required permissions, we expect that the ground-breaking ceremony will take place this year," the IAS officer said.

He urged defence manufacturers to set up plants at Dholera, saying the city has enough land for them. "In the defence sector, companies require huge tracts of land. They need around 400 to 500 hectares of land. Such large land parcels are not available anywhere (else) in India," he said.

"We have land parcels as large as 750 hectares....we have a world-class infrastructure and all pending works will be finished by September 2019. We are getting many queries from potential investors from the defence sector," he added.

Govt promoting Dholera as investment destination for defence ...



AHMEDABAD: The Government of is promoting the Special Investment Region as an ideal destination for investments in the defence manufacturing sector. Authorities plan to host a summit at Dholera ahead of the Summit. Dholera is 110km from Ahmedabad.

"We are capable of providing huge land parcels that are required for defence manufacturing facilities," said Jai Prakash Shivhare, the managing director of the Dholera Industrial City Development (DICC) Ltd. "Such a facility needs 400-500 hectares of land. Such large land parcels are not available anywhere in India." Shivhare was present at the Defence Conclave 2018, organized by the Confederation of Indian Industry and Society of Indian Defence Manufacturers.

Chief minister Vijay Rupani has said that Vibrant Gujarat Summit 2019 will project Dholera as a key investment destination," Shivhare said. "The pre-Vibrant event at Dholera will push for investments in the region." Several international players have expressed interest in setting up manufacturing facilities at Dholera SIR. "Recently, we presented the aspects of Dholera SIR at the DefExpo 2018 in Chennai," Shivhare said. "American defence and aerospace giant Lockheed Martin has shown interest in Dholera SIR, especially for manufacturing batteries as a 5,000 megawatt solar power plant is coming up in the region. The company representatives will visit Dholera in June." Airbus signed a memorandum of understanding at the last Vibrant Summit and will invest at an appropriate time, he said. In the wake of massive investments in the region, several power companies have shown interest in seeking a distribution licence in the region. The state government is looking at pushing investments in other sectors in the region as it falls on the Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC).


The government hopes to sign these memoranda of understanding during Vibrant Gujarat Summit in January next year. The MRO facilities are likely to bring in investments worth Rs 700


ET independently checked with AAI officials, who confirmed that DICDL has proposed a 51:49 partnership for the airport, which is now under consideration.

However, the official added that the proposal has not yet been accepted by AAI, yet. The earlier proposal was of 74:26 JV, which AAI had not accepted.

The Dholera Industrial City Development (DICDL) is the special purpose vehicle (SPV) formed by the DMIC Trust and the government of Gujarat to administer the special investment region (SIR). It is seeking investments from defendant

with a total footprint of over 920 sq km, Dholera is the biggest of the eight industrial smart cities being developed in the first phase of the sight industrial smart cities being developed in the first phase of the \$100 billion DMIC project. The 22,5 sq km of activation zone entailing an investment of ₹4,400 crore will be infrastructurally ready by September 2019 and is up for grabs for investment, he said.

"With six town planning schemes in place, this is the first mega project of its kind wherein existing land owners will not be disturbed as the project gets underway." he explained. There are 22 villages with about 30,000 people under the SIR. "Rather than acquiring land from private owners, government has earmarked the entire region. We will market only 280 sq km of government land that belongs to us. Private owners can decide what to do with their land parcels eventually," he said. The entire project span is 30 years and would cost ₹30,000 crore.






